Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine Info Sheet

Your child has been scheduled to receive their Pfizer COVID-19 vaccination. Their 2nd Pfizer COVID-19 vaccination booster will automatically be scheduled for 3 weeks after the 1st dose at the exact same time as the 1st dose.

- It is imperative that your child is here on time for their scheduled appointment. Each vial of vaccine contains 6 doses of vaccine, and in an effort to minimize vaccine loss, our office is scheduling 6 patients per block of time.
- If we are unable to schedule a total of 6 patients for each block of time, you will be called and asked to reschedule.

Prior to your child's scheduled vaccine:

- Please print and complete the attached screening and consent form

On the day of your child's vaccine:

- Please arrive at least 5-10min before your scheduled vaccination time.
- Please remain in your car, and call us at 402-330-5690 for further instructions
- Your child will need to remain in our office for at least 15 minutes after receiving each dose of the COVID-19 vaccination.
- We do NOT recommend pre-treating your child with any over-the-counter pain or fever-reducing medications

COVID-19 Vaccination Information:

- It is common to experience an immune reaction from this vaccination and you may or may not experience symptoms after the 1st, 2nd, or both doses of the COVID-19 vaccination. The following immune reaction symptoms are common (this list is not all-inclusive).
 - Arm soreness, redness or swelling
 - Fever/Chills
 - Body Aches/Muscle Pain
 - Fatigue
 - Headache
 - Nausea
- It is important to note that the COVID-19 vaccine can NOT cause COVID-19 infection
- The Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine does not contain eggs, preservatives, or latex
